Pavilion Rental Rates

The pavilion is available for rental during the following three-hour time slots:

Saturdays: 10 am - 1 pm or 2:30 pm - 5:30 pm

Sundays: 10am- 1pm

Costs: Residents: \$100*; Others: \$175*

After Hours: 7 pm - 10 pm
Costs: Residents: \$424*; Others: \$530* (Up to 50 people - additional charge for extra people)
