APPLICATION CHECKLIST

The following checklist is designed to assist the applicant in preparing the required materials for review. The five (5) following items are required as part of a complete application:

- A completed City of Tamarac Residential Tree Removal Application.
- Property Survey or Sketch showing the location, species and diameter of the tree(s) to be removed and showing the proposed location, species and size of replacement tree(s).
- Homeowners Association Approval Letter: Provide letter from HOA either approving or stating approval is not required.
- Application fee (see attached fee schedule). Make check payable to the City of Tamarac.

How to determine the Diameter of a tree:

- Measure the Tree Circumference at 4.5ft above ground
- Diameter = Circumference x .31831

For example a Tree with a 12 in. circumference at 4.5ft above ground has a diameter of 3.8 in.

If your tree is 18 inches or more in diameter at 4.5ft above ground, contact the Community Development Department / Planning & Zoning to determine if your tree is a "specimen tree".

Tree Replacement:

- Removed trees should be replaced with similar trees within 60 days of approval. Shade trees should be replaced with shade trees, palm trees with palm trees and small trees with small trees.
- A list of species approved for planting in the City of Tamarac can be found in Tables 10-5.0, 10-5.1, 10-5.2, and 10-5.4 in Section 10-4.4 "Landscaping and Tree Preservation" of the City of Tamarac Land Development Code.
